CONSOLIDATED EDISON COMPANY (INDIAN POINT 2) DOCKET NO. 50-247

The attached report of a visit on April 22-24, 1968 to the Combustion Engineering Company, the fabricator of the reactor pressure vessel for the subject facility, is forwarded for information.

This visit represents the final shop inspection of the subject vessel. The Assistant Director for Technical Programs reports that based on the observations reported here and in previous reports, it is concluded that the Indian Point 2 vessel is acceptable and of excellent quality.

It is noted that additional ultrasonic testing was scheduled to follow the hydrostatic test. The results of this testing, to be documented in the vessel fabrication report, will be reviewed by the inspector when this information becomes available.
