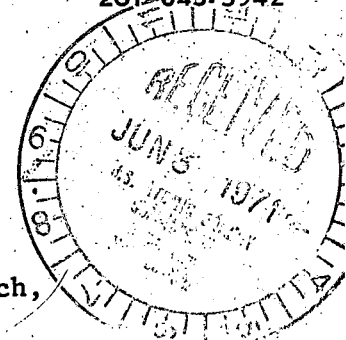



The attached report of an announced inspection at the subject facility on March 2-4, 1971 is forwarded for information. The subject of the adequacy of the liquid waste processing system was discussed in meetings at HQ with Westinghouse and Con Ed on April 27 and April 30, 1970. As you are aware, Westinghouse-Con Ed have promised to upgrade the performance of the waste evaporator and/or install a demineralizer in the system.

We are continuing to followup the identified areas where the installations differ from published standards or where our experience indicates that possible problem areas exist. These conditions are not at variance with FSAR commitments, however, we expect modifications to be made in those situations where Con Ed evaluations do not indicate that existing conditions are satisfactory.
