Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. G. L. Madsen of this office on March 14 and 15, 1972 and April 10 and 14, 1972 of activities authorized by AEC License Nos. CPPR-21 and DPR-26 and to discussions of our findings held by Mr. Madsen with Messrs. Makepeace and Kohler of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during this inspection included the test programs relating to the November 4, 1971 fire; the subcritical test program; the power ascension program; the pipe hanger and restraint installation; the pipe thermal expansion program; the safety injection system modification; and the resolution of previously identified unresolved items. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with plant personnel, and observations by our inspector.

No items of nonconformance or noncompliance were identified in the areas examined during this inspection.
