The items of concern to our consultant Arnold A. Weintraub relating to fire prevention and protection were well received by the licensee. Some of the items had already been corrected, and some items are under consideration by the licensee.

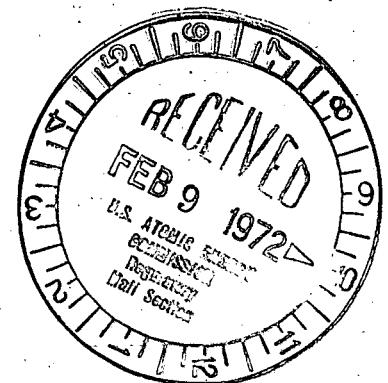
The test program, relating to the fire damage, is basically a check-out of the components affected by the fire. Con Ed plans to include the performance of most of the operational surveillance and preventive maintenance tests prior to going critical. The licensee's test program appears to be conservative and realistic.

In our letter to the licensee we have requested a written response to establish his schedule for the submittal to DRL of two reports on steam generator repair. These reports have not been received and were discussed in previous letters to the licensee.
