

Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspections conducted by Mr. Madsen of this office on August 12, 17, 18 and 25 and September 2, 1971 of construction activities authorized by AEC Construction Permit No. CPPR-21 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Madsen with Messrs. Makepeace and Kohler of your staff at the conclusion of the inspections.

Areas examined during the inspections included preoperational testing, the power ascension testing program, the pipe support and restraint installation, the steam generator clad separation repair, and the status of previously identified unresolved items. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, discussions with plant personnel, and observations by our inspector.

During the inspection, it was found that certain of your activities appeared to be in nonconformance with statements in the Final Safety Analysis Report and Part 50 of the Commission Regulations. The specific items and references to the pertinent requirements are included in the enclosure to this letter. Please provide us within 30 days, in writing, with your comments concerning these items; any steps which have been or will be taken to correct them, any steps that have been or will be taken to prevent recurrence, and the date all corrective actions or preventive measures were or will be completed.
