
Your letter dated April 2, 1975 stated that an inspection conducted by Mr. Panzarino of your office on January 29-31, February 6-7, 13-14, 1975 of activities authorized by NRC Facility License No. DPR-26, indicated that one of our activities appeared to be in violation of Technical Specification requirements. Specifically, contrary to Technical Specification 6.9.1, procedure SAO-105/Revision 2 was not followed in that holders of certain Radiation Work Permits (RWP's) failed to sign or otherwise indicate that the workers covered by RWP's had been informed of the existing radiological conditions and protection required at the work locations.

We have reviewed each RWP in question and have determined that, while the RWP holder did not sign or otherwise indicate that the workers covered by the RWP's had been informed of the existing radiological conditions and protection required at the work locations, in each case the RWP holder had discussed the provisions of the RWP with each working group but, through an oversight, failed to record his method of informing the working group. We will reinstruct all personnel in the requirement to adhere to all

provisions of SAO-105. Further, in order to ascertain compliance with the requirements of SAO-105, and to monitor the effectiveness of our reinstruction, we have intensified our field monitoring program whereby representatives of our Health Physics Unit conduct inspections of job locations and observe personnel performing the work covered by the RWP.
