
This refers to Inspection 50-247/80-22, conducted by Mr. H. Baunack, Acting Senior Resident Inspector, on December 1 to 19, 1980, of activities authorized by NRC License DPR-26 at Indian Point Station, and a clarifying conversation between Mr. Baunack and Mr. Monti, of February 27, 1981 with reference to Item 2.C(4) (URI 247/80-22-05) of this Inspection.

Complete plant inspections were conducted over the period of December 17, 1980 to January 3, 1981 by the Chief Operations Engineer, Plant Manager, and Manager of Nuclear Power Generation. The purposes of these inspections were to determine if plant safety items existed and to view the total housekeeping effort.

The inspections did not identify any plant safety issues, but did identify housekeeping matters that require correction, and these have been assigned to appropriate personnel who have already initiated corrective actions. Copies of the detailed findings of the inspections are available for review. The plant Manager has follow-up responsibility for these matters. We recognize that housekeeping is a dynamic situation and therefore these types of inspections are not only one-time efforts. With the outage presently in progress the situation is even more dynamic. We are giving continuous attention to these matters at the daily outage meetings, during plant tours by management, and by speaking directly with workers.

If there are any further questions we would be pleased to address them.
