If you had the impression that I was not too happy with that meeting, especially the way Greg and Tim came into the meeting, you are correct. I had a long talk this morning with Larry Campbell which revolved around "This is a hell of a way to run a railroad." That said, lets go on.

We can't ignore the YMRP. I have never liked it, but we are going to have to use it. We also have to realize the DOE is at a [REDACTED] you - In your Face" frame of mind. so what do we send back. Here is my "outline"

1. We have read your letter asserting that the information in reference I (the original submittal) was sufficient to close the agreement. We didn't agree then and we don't now.
2. We have read your latest letter and as regards to the 4 points they all miss the point. (Short dissection of the garbage presented.)
4. We consider that the plan of attack, as outlined in the meeting of July 1, of aeromag, drilling, lab and reconvening the elicitation panel represents a reasonable approach to resolving this concern. We also recognize that this will not be complete until FY 2006 while the license application is to come in FY 2004.
5. We recognize that you have drawn a line in the sand and will not provide anything else for the LA, so we will not expect anything more and review what information is contained in the license application. Based on what has been presented to date we fully expect that we will issue a request for additional information which would state that we need the results of your planned work (the survey, drilling lab and results from the reconvened expert elicitation)
6. At this time we consider 1.02 open.
