Dear Mr. Farvardin:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 11 to your NRC Material License No. 13-25890-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

In correspondence dated October 13, 2009, you indicated that you relocated your Indianapolis office, and therefore, wished to release for unrestricted use the former storage location at 6125 S. East Street, Indianapolis, Indiana.

The NRC staff has reviewed your final status surveys. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your former storage location and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria. Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required for this storage location and it is suitable for unrestricted use.

As a reminder, an NRC-approved license amendment is required before receiving, using, and storing licensed material at an address or location not included with the application or already listed on the license.

Please note that License Condition No. 22 has been added along with verbiage in License Condition 20, both of which do not add new requirements but highlight the regulatory requirements.

Also, per our telephone conversation on December 31, 2009, you indicated that the suite number for your new Indianapolis office was not necessary in License Condition 10. If there is an error in my understanding, please feel free to contact me.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). The NRC's document system is accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html> (the Public Electronic Reading Room).

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions.

Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
