Dear Dr. Auerbach:

It is my understanding that permission has now been given for the parties in the Atomic Energy Commission's proceeding on Indian Point 2 to hold informal discussions with the members of the Oak Ridge team who worked on the Indian Point 2 environmental statement.

In order to expedite the hearing process and to focus any areas of disagreement which may arise among the parties, I would like to begin immediately to have the Intervenor's experts, principally John R. Clark and Ernst Habicht, meet with various members of the Oak Ridge team at mutually convenient times and places to discuss the content of the Indian Point 2 statement.

I have written Myron Karman, the AEC attorney, to this effect and I enclose a copy of the letter to Mr. Karman.

I would appreciate it if you would confirm this procedure as soon as possible.
