INDIAN POINT UNIT NO. 2 - 50% MINI STATEMENT

Phil Goodyear, ecologist from ORNL will be here on Tuesday, December 7, 1971 to talk with J. Swinebroad and me regarding the ecological section on Indian Point Unit No. 2. For your information, the ecological section on Indian Point Unit No. 2 was sent to New York University and Woods Hole for comments by E. Struxness. I don't know the names of the persons involved, but according to B. Yee, the man at Woods Hole is a friend of John Clark, the fish expert and former employee of Woods Hole, who is an intervenor with the Natural Resources Defense Council (NRDC). Also NYU is conducting fish studies for Con Ed and it may be the same people who will review the ORNL ecological section. According to M. Karman, we have several commitments besides the 50% and 100% statements. One is comments on the answers by Con Ed to questions originated by NRDC. Second is answers by DREP to a few questions from NRDC. Third is a list of references used in the DES drafts. B. Yee has a copy of the different NRDC sets of questions I-IV and answers and will assist me in supplying comments. Also M. Karman stated that contacts with other Federal agencies were mentioned and that the Hearing Examiner, S. Jensch, requested that we get comments on our ministatements before the next hearing of December 14, 1971. Arrangements should be made to send out the 50% ministatement to Federal agencies, such as EPA, U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service, and Corps of Engineers and to set up a meeting by December 13.
