In connection with our discussions with the Council on Environmental Quality on the review of environmental statements for nuclear power plants in light of the Calvert Cliffs' decision, I am forwarding under separate cover copies of a supplemental report on Indian Point, Unit 2, prepared by the Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc., and copies of supplemental information on the Palisades Nuclear Power Station prepared by the Consumers Power Company. These reports are incomplete and we expect additional information to be submitted particularly as pertains to transportation, transmission lines and accidents.
