INDIAN POINT 2 DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL STATEMENT

Following our brief discussion today on the subject matter, I checked into the Summary and Conclusions section of the Indian Point 2 statement and found the following two sentences under section 5.f on pages v and vi:

"The applicant will be required to complete the detailed design study and a progress report on the results of the environmental monitoring program within a period of 15 months from the date of initiation of steady-state power operation. Within the second year of operation the AEC will evaluate the results of the monitoring program and the design study and will determine the extent of any actions to be imposed on the applicant to minimize impact."

Since the information you related to me is not consistent with the above statements, I would appreciate your looking into the matter further.
