
RESPONSE OF AEC REGULATORY STAFF TO MOTION OF APPLICANT  
TO PRESCRIBE TIME FOR COMPLETION OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEARING

On April 10, 1972, the applicant filed a motion requesting the Board to establish a schedule for completion of the hearing on applicant's motion for a limited power authorization under 10 CFR 50, Appendix D, Section D.2.

The Board has already scheduled a session to commence on May 17, 1972, for the purpose of: (1) hearing testimony relevant to certain allegations concerning the safety of the plant, and (2) beginning the cross-examination of applicant's environmental witnesses.

The regulatory staff assumes that the Board and parties will continue with the environmental issues without undue delay, as contemplated by 10 CFR 50, Appendix D. It is to be noted that the Draft Detailed Statement of the regulatory staff was served on the Board and parties on April 14, 1972.
