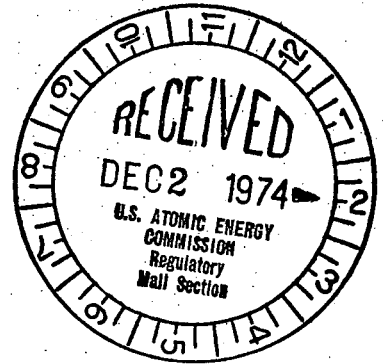

APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT TO
FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc., (Con Edison) as holder of Facility Operating License No. DPR-26, hereby requests that said license be amended by adding a new subparagraph 2.E. (5) as follows:

"(5) Subject to all of the foregoing provisions of this Paragraph 2.E., the Atomic Energy Commission has determined, following review of the document entitled "Economic and Environmental Impacts of Alternative Closed-Cycle cooling Systems for Indian Point Unit No. 2" dated December 1, 1974, that a closed-cycle natural draft, wet cooling tower system is the preferred alternative closed-cycle cooling system for installation at Indian Point Unit No. 2".

In compliance with Paragraph 2.E (2) of Facility Operating License No. DPR-26, and in support of this Application, Con Edison submits the document entitled "Economic and Environmental Impacts of Alternative Closed-Cycle Cooling Systems for Indian Point Unit No. 2".

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On the basis of the information set forth in that document, Con Edison has determined that a natural draft, closed-cycle, wet cooling tower system would be the preferred system for installation at Indian Point Unit No. 2 if an alternative closed-cycle system is required.
