Dear Mr. Reinfelder:

In response to your request of March 20, 1973, with respect to reports of fish kills at any and all nuclear power plants along the coast, we are enclosing copies of the Final Environmental Statement for Indian Point Nuclear Generating Plant Unit 2, Volumes I and II; RO Inquiry Report Nos. 50-219/73-02Q and 50-219/73-03Q; CO Inquiry Report No. 50-219/72-03 on Oyster Creek fish kills; Vepco Technical Specifications Occurrence Report; Preliminary Analysis and Evaluation of Reported Impingement Losses at Surry Power Plant; and, Compilation and Correlation Analysis of Published and Unpublished Environmental Data with Distribution, Abundance, and Movements of Young Menhaden in Mid-Atlantic Estuaries. These reports provide pertinent information on fish kills at each of the Indian Point, Oyster Creek, and Surry Nuclear Power Stations.

It is the policy of the Atomic Energy Commission (AEC) to place a copy of each inquiry report, inspection report and other docketed material in the AEC Public Document Room (PDR) at 1717 H Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20545 and also in the local PDR established for each nuclear power station. The specific type of information requested by your organization will be located in the PDRs. Corresponding to the interests of your organization with fish kills at all nuclear power plants along the coast, your members living along the coast near these power plants should utilize the PDR facilities conveniently located nearby. For the information of your membership, a listing of PDR addresses for all docketed reactors is enclosed.

As a further aid to your obtaining future information that may be placed in the PDR, it might be helpful to monitor the "Public Document Round-Up" found in the Atomic Energy Clearing House which is published
