WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Cortlandt has evaluated the impact of the construction of two 560 foot high cooling towers on Con-Edison Indian Point Property situated in the Village of Buchanan, Town of Cortlandt, Westchester County, New York, and

WHEREAS, a report has been made to the Town Board by the Town Engineering Department, based on a visit to plants smaller in size, in Pennsylvania,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Cortlandt does hereby express its concern for the health and safety of the citizens of the Town, along with the plant and wild-life, if two 560 foot high cooling towers are erected on this site, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Cortlandt does hereby vigorously oppose the erection of the cooling towers for reasons of climatic impact, the effect they will have on plant and human life, reduced visibility impact and adverse aesthetic impact, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk of the Town of Cortlandt is hereby directed to inform Con Edison and all governmental agencies having jurisdiction in this matter, that the Town of Cortlandt is unequivocally opposed to the erection of these cooling towers.
