



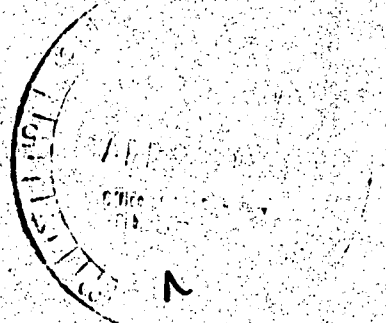

In reference to your letter of March 12, 1973, the Regulatory Staff is in the process of developing proposed Environmental Technical Specifications with Consolidated Edison as a requirement for an operating license for full power for Indian Point Unit No. 2. The proposed Technical Specifications submitted by the applicant on March 1, 1973, have been reviewed by the staff and will be modified by the applicant in accordance with the staff's comments presented to the applicant at a meeting on March 27, 1973. The final proposed Environmental Technical Specifications will be submitted to the ASLB and the parties in the proceeding prior to the Board's initial decision.

Comments on the March 1, 1973, draft and the future drafts from all parties in the proceeding will be welcome. If desired, a meeting may be set up to discuss your comments, particularly after the next draft is received from the applicant.
