Pursuant to Appendix B of Unit No. 2 Technical Specifications with respect to the operation of our Unit Nos. 1 and 2, a tabulation of daily record of fish collections at Indian Point Unit No. 2 for the month of January is enclosed herewith. A daily species breakdown and total daily weights are also included. Subsequent to the impingement total of 18,816 on January 22, circulator 26 was shutdown (circulator 21 had been previously shutdown). Because the circulators at Unit No. 1 were shutdown the entire month, there were no fish collections made.


