



Dear Mr. Knighton:

This is in reply to your letter dated November 10, 1975.

In response to your request for data collected during 1974, we are forwarding to you magnetic tapes and related documentation for the 1974 data, the titles of which appear in Attachment A. With these computer tapes and documentation, it will be possible for your staff to print out the data in a format similar to that which appeared in the 1973 Data Summary, or in any other format that may be desired. The associated magnetic tape and documentation for 1974 water quality data is currently in preparation and will be forwarded shortly. We do not have available printouts of the 1974 data.

We have also obtained, and are also enclosing per your request, 2 copies of the 4-volume report prepared by Lawler, Matusky & Skelly for the Empire State Electric Energy Research Corporation entitled "Hudson River Study - Aquatic Factors Governing the Siting of Power Plants." This is a compilation of material previously published, most of which, I believe, has been furnished to the NRC in testimony or report form at various earlier dates.


