

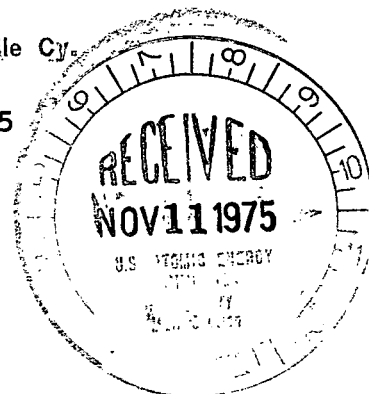

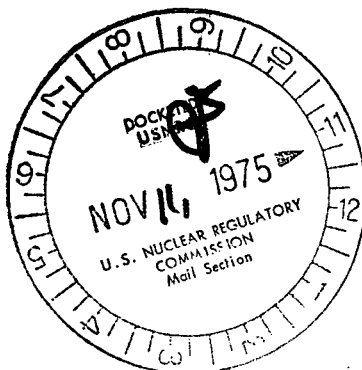


- (a) Tape - "TI 1974 ichthyoplankton data" - with documentation (11 pages).
