Gentlemen

We are providing the following information in response to a request by Mr. Cliff Haupt in reference to your Staff's assessment of the potential environmental impact of the proposed Indian Point Unit No. 2 fuel storage pool modification.

The present estimated additional fuel cost to replace the output of Indian Point Unit No. 2 on a day of full-power operation, utilizing existing oil-fired generating units, is about \$480,000. Therefore, the operation of Indian Point Unit No. 2 results in a total savings to Con Edison's customers of about \$550,000 per day, including applicable taxes. The additional oil consumption required to replace Indian Point Unit No. 2 would be about 40,000 barrels per day.
