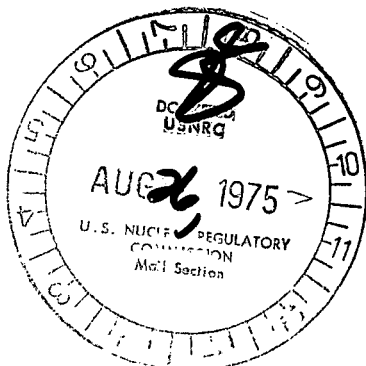
This is in response to your letter dated August 14, 1975, which was received on August 18, concerning the planned visit to the Indian Point site and environs by members of your staff on August 21, 1975.

The advance list of questions attached to your letter is helpful to us in preparing for the visit, and we will have people available on August 21 to respond to those questions. Unfortunately, the short notice we had of your wish to meet with representatives from York Research Corporation and Pickard, Lowe and Associates, Inc. during your visit is causing us a problem in trying to comply with your request. As I previously explained to your staff, we are not always successful in committing our outside consultants on such short notice. We have no control of their daily schedules and they frequently have prior commitments with other clients. We have been able to obtain a representative from York Research Corporation for the meeting but have not obtained a representative from Pickard, Lowe and Associates, Inc.

Dr. Oestmann has clarified with Mr. Edward J. Sack that the request for consultants was not intended to expand the agenda beyond the items attached to your letter. We will be prepared to proceed on that basis.
