Pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 and the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations in 10 CFR Part 51 (formerly Appendix D to 10 CFR 50), notice is hereby given that a Draft Environmental Statement prepared by the Commission's Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation related to the preferred closed cycle cooling system for installation at Indian Point Unit No. 2, located in Westchester County, New York, is available for inspection by the public in the Commission's Public Document Room at 1717 H Street, N. W., Washington, D. C., and in the Hendrick Hudson Free Library, 31 Albany Post Road, Montrose, New York 10548. The Draft Statement is also being made available at the New York State Office of Planning Services, 488 Broadway, Albany, New York, 12207 and the Tri-State Regional Planning Commission, 1 World Trade Center, New York, New York 10048. Requests for copies of the Draft Environmental Statement should be addressed to the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, D. C. 20555, Attention: Director, Division of Site Safety and Environmental Analysis.

The Applicant's Environmental Report, as supplemented, submitted by the Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc., is also available for public inspection at the above-designated locations. Notice of availability of the Applicant's Environmental Report was published in the FEDERAL REGISTER on March 3, 1975 (40 FR 8855).



Comments by Federal, State, and local officials, or other persons received by the Commission will be made available for public inspection at the Commission's Public Document Room in Washington, D. C. and the Hendrick Hudson Free Library, 31 Albany Post Road, Montrose, New York. Upon consideration of comments submitted with respect to the Draft Environmental Statement, the Commission's staff will prepare a Final Environmental Statement, the availability of which will be published in the FEDERAL REGISTER.

This confirms our telephoned authorization given today, January 24, 1976 for a change in Technical Specifications for the Indian Point Nuclear Generating Unit No. 2 as requested by your letter of November 6, 1975. Facility Operating License No. DPR-26 is amended on this date, January 24, 1976, by making the following technical specification change:

Appendix B, Page 4-35

"(ii) If the number of fish of all sizes and species killed exceeds 5000 per day for seven consecutive days or the number of fish of all sizes killed exceeds 15,000 per day for three consecutive days, immediate corrective action shall be taken to reduce the number killed to below these levels."

Copies of the license amendment, Federal Register Notice and Environmental Evaluation for this technical specification change will be sent to you when completed.
