SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF PUBLIC MEETING HELD DECEMBER 16, 2009,
WHICH DISCUSSED A LICENSE AMENDMENT REQUEST
TEMPLATE FOR NUCLEAR POWER PLANTS TRANSITIONING TO
NATIONAL FIRE PROTECTION ASSOCIATION 805

On December 16, 2009, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) held a Category 3 public meeting to discuss a license amendment request (LAR) template for nuclear power plants transitioning to a fire protection program based on the National Fire Protection Association Standard 805 (NFPA 805). During the discussion the NRC staff shared the lessons learned to date resulting from the review of the two pilot plant LARs. An attendance list is included in this summary as an enclosure.

Summary of Meeting

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss recent activities on the part of the NRC staff and the industry to update the NFPA 805 safety evaluation template and LAR template, respectively. The meeting notice can be found under Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) accession number ML093350369. The NRC staff provided the structure of the most recent draft of an NFPA 805 transition safety evaluation (ML100221291) as a handout. Three sets of slides were presented at the meeting. First, an overview of activities related to updating a safety evaluation template can be found in ADAMS, under accession number ML100220999. Second, slides presenting some early insights learned through the review of a pilot LAR were presented by the NRC staff (ADAMS ML100221028). Lastly, the Nuclear Energy Institute writing team presented the status of the LAR template guidance update (ADAMS ML100221240).

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Discussion at the meeting focused on the recent experience of the NRC staff in the review of the two pilot plant LARs. Participants also discussed recent efforts by the Nuclear Energy Institute writing team to update the LAR submittal guidance. Lastly, participants shared schedule information related to the issuance of updated LAR submittal guidance and the issuance of a safety evaluation template for the NFPA 805 transition program.

Members of the general public did not have any questions or comments during the meeting. No conclusions were made regarding these technical topics that were discussed.
