Dear Mr. Gerusky:

A copy of a notice which was published in the Federal Register on May 17, 1967, is enclosed for your information. The notice relates to an application filed by Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. for authorization to construct and operate a third pressurized water nuclear reactor designated as Indian Point Station Unit No. 3, at the applicant's Indian Point Station site, located on the east bank of the Hudson River in the village of Buchanan, Westchester County, New York.

The proposed Indian Point Station Unit No. 3 is designed for initial operation at approximately 3,025 thermal megawatts with a net electrical output of approximately 965 megawatts. The reactor is to be located adjacent to and south of the existing Indian Point Station Unit No. 1. A second nuclear reactor, Indian Point Station Unit No. 2, is presently under construction on this site.
