NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF APPLICATION FOR CONSTRUCTION PERMIT AND FACILITY LICENSE

Please take notice that Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc., 4 Irving Place, New York, New York 10003, pursuant to Section 104b. of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, has filed an application, dated April 25, 1967, for a construction permit and facility license to authorize construction and operation of a pressurized water nuclear reactor at the applicant's Indian Point Station. The site comprises approximately 250 acres on the east bank of the Hudson River in the Village of Buchanan, Westchester County, New York.

The proposed reactor, designated by the applicant as Indian Point Station Unit No. 3, is designed for initial operation at approximately 3,025 thermal megawatts with a net electrical output of approximately 965 megawatts. The reactor is to be located adjacent to and south of the existing Indian Point Station Unit No. 1. A second nuclear reactor, Indian Point Station Unit No. 2, is presently under construction on this site.
