

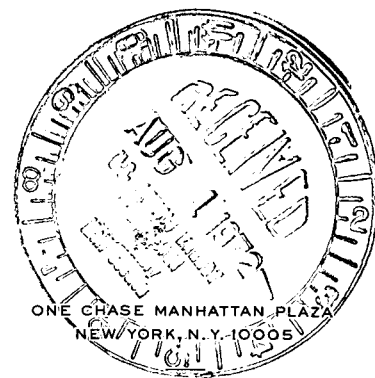

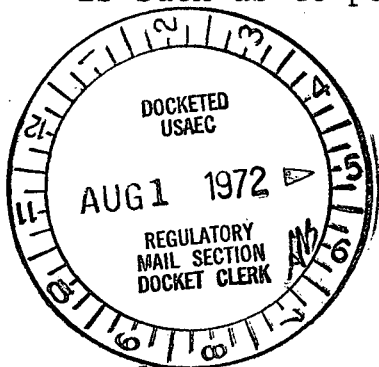
Copies of these documents have been served upon Mayor George Segnit of Buchanan, New York. A Certificate of Service is attached to this transmittal.
