


Dear Mr. Rusche:

Pursuant to Section 50.30(c)(1)(ii) we transmit herewith on behalf of the Power Authority of the State of New York and Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. three (3) originals and nineteen (19) copies of a document entitled "Application to Amend Operating License" for Indian Point Unit No. 3. The purpose of the requested amendment is to permit the Power Authority to purchase and acquire title to Unit No. 3.

By an order dated April 8, 1975, the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board in this docket authorized the issuance of an interim operating license to Con Edison for Unit No. 3. While the license itself has not yet been issued, the form and timing of this application arises from the need to obtain the requested amendment by about July 1 without jeopardizing the timely issuance of the interim operating license.
