APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT TO
OPERATING LICENSE

Pursuant to Section 50.90 of the regulations of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison"), in its own right and as agent for Power Authority of the State of New York as coholder of Facility Operating License No. DPR-64, hereby applies for an amendment to the Indian Point Unit No. 3 Technical Specifications contained in Appendix A to that License.

Specifically, Con Edison requests changes to Sections 1.13 and 4.4.E.1 to clarify the surveillance interval applicable to refueling outage tests performed at the end of the first fuel cycle, and to make the surveillance interval for testing of containment isolation valves consistent with the requirements of Appendix J to Part 50 of the Commission's regulations, respectively.


The proposed Technical Specification changes consist of the specific revisions set forth in Attachment A to this Application. A safety evaluation of the proposed changes is set forth in Attachment B to this Application. This evaluation demonstrates

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
that the proposed changes do not represent a significant hazards consideration and will not cause any change in the types or increase in the amounts of effluents or any change in the authorized power level of the facility.
