Dear Sir:

Please be advised that as of March 10, 1978, the effective date of the operating license transfer to the Authority for the subject facility, the Consolidated Edison Company or LeBeouf, Lamb, Leiby and MacRae no longer act as "agent" for the Authority before the Nuclear Regulatory Commission for technical specification changes. This is true even if Con Edison and the Authority jointly submit proposed Environmental Technical Specification Changes dealing with the common portions of the ETS for the Indian Point site. Such joint applications are merely for the Commission's expediency in processing one set of common ETSR for the three nuclear facilities at the site. Any discussions or revisions to such jointly proposed ETSR should be discussed with both parties.
