Enclosed for filing are three (3) signed originals and nineteen (19) copies of a document entitled, "Application for Amendment to Operating License", and attachments thereto.

This application seeks to amend the submission time period for both non-radiological and radiological reports called for in the plant reporting requirements of Regulatory Guide 4.8 (December 1975 - Issued for comment). This guide requires that reports on environmental surveillance programs for the previous 12 months of operation shall be submitted within 90 days after January 1 of each year.

The Indian Point 3 Technical Specification Appendix B Section 5.6.1.1 was previously approved with a 120 day allowable time for the non-radiological report (Part A) and 90 days for the radiological report (Part B). However, when Amendment 12 to the Tech. Specs. were issued, these requirements were changed to 90 days in accordance with the Regulatory Guide. We are requesting by the attached amendment to revise the allowable time for both reports to 120 days.
