1. "Application for Amendment to Operating License," sworn to on December 16, 1977. This application requests an amendment to the Technical Specifications for Indian Point Unit No. 3, to permit the removal of the part length control rods from the reactor vessel. Approval of the requested Technical Specification changes will facilitate the part length control rod removal during the first refueling outage scheduled to begin in the Spring of 1978.

2. "Application for Amendment to Operating License," sworn to on December 16, 1977. This application requests revisions to sections 3.6 and 4.4 in the Technical Specifications to update Tables 3.6-1 and 4.4-1 to reflect addition of hardware


