

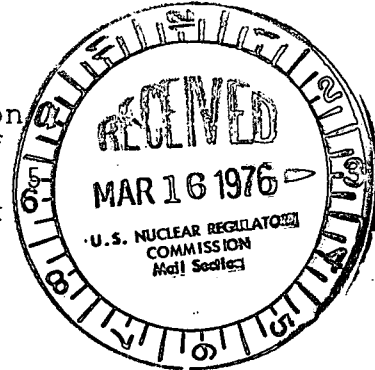

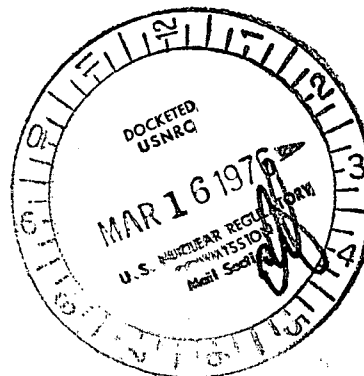
Dear Mr. Vassallo:

We wish to clarify our response to Question 9.34 in the Indian Point Unit No. 3 FSAR which indicates that all gaseous flows from the primary auxiliary building (PAB) will pass through roughing, HEPA and charcoal filters. The system will be operated in such a manner that all gaseous flows will pass through the roughing and HEPA filters at all times and, on high gross activity in the PAB, gaseous effluents will be passed through the charcoal filters.
