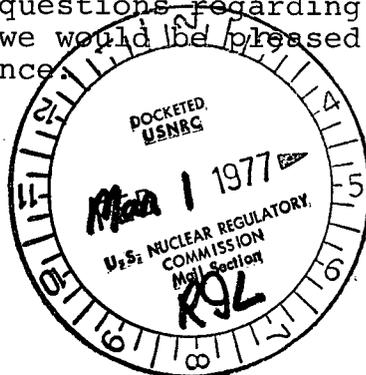


Dear Mr. Reid:

Your letter of January 10, 1977 requested that Con Edison identify the implementation option which we intend to follow in installing our Overpressure Protection System (OPS). Our schedule calls for installation of such a "long-term improvement" by December 31, 1977. We intend to satisfy the requirements of implementation Option 1 as outlined in your letter.

The Con Edison conceptual design for the OPS appears as Attachment 1 to this letter. The response analyses for this system are expected to be completed by April 30, 1977. The results of these analyses will be submitted to you shortly thereafter. Because of the tight schedule for installation of the OPS, however, we have begun requisitioning of the hardware with long lead delivery requirements. For this reason, we require a prompt review of our proposed system, and therefore request your approval of the OPS by March 25, 1977.

Included as Attachment 2 to this letter are the responses to your questions which were transmitted to us in your letter of January 10, 1977. Should you or your staff have any further questions regarding these responses or the proposed system, we would be pleased to discuss them with you at your convenience.
