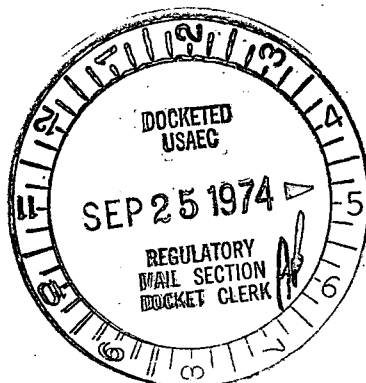
In response to your letter of October 9, 1973 and subsequent conversations with the Regulatory Staff, we are submitting the following schedule regarding the anticipated transients without scram (ATWS) analysis. This analysis will conform to the approach described in Section II.B in Appendix A of WASH-1270.

At present, Westinghouse Electric Corporation has completed a generic ATWS analysis for units utilizing their Series 51 steam generators. We have been informed by Westinghouse that they intend to submit this analysis to the Commission by October 1, 1974 in the form of Westinghouse Topical Report WCAP-8330. This publication will augment their previous report WCAP-7486.

Although these analyses are generally applicable to Indian Point Unit No. 3, a supplemental study for plants like Unit No. 3 which has Series 44 steam generators is necessary. Based on Westinghouse's schedule for completion and Con Edison review of this additional analysis, our report completing the ATWS evaluation for Indian Point Unit No. 3 will be provided to the AEC by November 8, 1974.
