This letter is provided for Indian Point 3 Nuclear Power Plant (Docket No. 50-286, License No. DPR-64) in response to IE Bulletin No. 78-07 regarding the respiratory protection program pursuant to 10 CFR 20.103.

The Indian Point 3 respiratory protection program does not, at this time, take credit for protection factors as stipulated in Regulatory Guide 8.15 in estimating exposures of individuals to concentrations of radioactive materials in air in restricted areas.

When and if our program is modified to allow use of protection factors, the information in IE Bulletin No. 78-07 will be incorporated.
