APPLICATION TO WITHHOLD DOCUMENTS  
FROM PUBLIC DISCLOSURE

Pursuant to 2.790 (b) of the Rules of Practice of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("the Commission"), 10 CFR 2.790 (b) (1977), Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison"), in its own right and as agent for Power Authority of the State of New York, coholder of Facility Operating License No. DPR-64, hereby applies for an order withholding from public disclosure Westinghouse Electric Corporation ("Westinghouse") documents entitled "Results of the October 1976 Augmented Startup Program Test Conducted at Indian Point Unit 3" and "Results of the January 1977 Augmented Startup Program Tests Conducted at Indian Point Unit 3". Westinghouse is the owner of this information.

Con Edison is advised that the documents cited above include information proprietary to Westinghouse and of the same technical type as Westinghouse information submitted to the Commission on April 20, 1977 in this docket and on July 19, 1976 for Commonwealth Edison Company (Zion Station Units No. 1 & 2, Docket Nos. 50-299, 50-304) and Indiana & Michigan Electric Co. (Donald Cook Unit No. 1, Docket No. 50-315).

An affidavit supporting this application for withholding, executed by Mr. Robert A. Wieseemann, Licensing Programs Manager for Westinghouse and dated July 14, 1977, is attached. That affidavit demonstrates entitlement to withholding from public disclosure of the two documents noted above.

WHEREFORE, Con Edison respectfully requests that the contents of the above-noted Westinghouse documents be withheld from public disclosure.
