Gentlemen:

By letter dated March 16, 1977, you requested an amendment to License No. DPR-64 to permit the Power Authority to assume sole responsibility for operation of Indian Point Unit No. 3 (IP-3). During our review of that application, we reviewed the Emergency Plan submitted for IP-3. The IP-3 plan is essentially the same plan that is now in effect for the Indian Point Station, with the exception of modifications to account for the transfer of the operating authority to PASHY. We have found both plans acceptable; however, we have issued Regulatory Guide 1.101 Revision No. 1 since the Consolidated Edison Indian Point Station emergency plan was approved. Therefore, both plans do not fully conform to current NRC guidance and we have concluded that a program to revise the emergency plans should be initiated. Specific examples of where the current emergency plans do not meet current guidance are as follows:

- (1) a spectrum of postulated accidents or a summary analysis of their implications for emergency planning is not provided (Regulatory Guide 1.101, Section 4.2) and
- (2) the plans also do not provide plots of calculated time-distance-dose for the design basis accident as delineated in Appendix 10 to Regulatory Guide 1.101, Revision No. 1.

The Power Authority of the State of New York and the Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. are therefore requested to submit, within 30 days of the date of this letter, schedules for submittal of revised emergency plans that will be consistent with the content and the format of Regulatory Guide 1.101, Revision No. 1.






