Dear Mr. Reid:

In response to your letter dated August 17, 1977, we are enclosing a proprietary affidavit to supplement the Westinghouse affidavit, AW-77-13, which accompanied the April 20, 1977, submittal of the Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc.

The proprietary affidavit identifies the information sought to be withheld from public disclosure and sets forth the basis on which the information may be withheld from public disclosure by the Commission. It addresses with specificity the considerations listed in 10 CFR Section 2.790(b)(4) of the Commission's regulations, as well as those listed on page 2 of the Commission's August 17 letter.

Because this supplemental affidavit contains Westinghouse proprietary information, it is being submitted in confidence and is marked Westinghouse Proprietary Class 2.
