
Subject: I.E. Bulletin 79-09

In response to Bulletin No. 79-09, the Power Authority has investigated the status of the Indian Point 3 Nuclear Power Plant with regard to the use of General Electric (G.E.) type Ak-2 Circuit Breakers.

Our investigation has confirmed that there are no G.E. type Ak-2 Circuit Breakers used in safety related systems. Furthermore, there are no plans to use any of these type breakers in our plant.
