
Dear Sir:

Thank you for the copies of "Discussions And Findings" by the Division of Reactor Licensing, relating to the proposed suspension of the Construction Permit for Indian Point Reactor # 3 pending National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) review; and the AEC's subsequent "Determination Not To Suspend Construction Activities," both of which were recently sent me.

Since erection of this third Indian Point nuclear reactor will raise the total power now represented there to 2,125 electric megawatts and increase its hazard radius to include the whole Metropolitan New York area, my personal interests are closely affected by the ruling and actions outlined in these documents.

I am therefore filing herewith my request, as an interested citizen of the area affected, for a special Public Hearing on the action and issues involved.
