Status Report for Week Ending October 19, 1974  
Pacific Gas and Electric Company  
Diablo Canyon Nuclear Plant, Units 1 & 2  
Docket Nos. 50-275/323

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SER (final copy), minus geology-seismology and hydrology evaluations, was issued on 10/16/74. Applicant's report on geology-seismology now expected to be submitted on 10/25/74; the report on tsunamis will be submitted around 11/1/74. The staff still plans to publish a supplement to the SER on geology-seismology and hydrology around 1/1/75. The full ACRS Committee Meeting would then be 2/7/75, and after issuance of a final SER supplement, the hearing would start on 3/28/75, with a PDD projected for 8/1/75. Fuel load for Unit 1 has now slipped to at least July of 1975, and will most likely slip further due to the total construction strike that is still in progress.

CONSOLIDATED EDISON COMPANY  
INDIAN POINT UNIT 3

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A consultant has come aboard to conduct financial evaluations and has picked up the review of Con Ed's financial qualifications. We still intend to report this evaluation in the IP-3 SER Supplement scheduled to be issued on November 15, 1974.

As a result of OGC review, the staff's response to Mr. Roisman's request for a show cause order on seismic concerns has been returned to TR for further work on the basis for allowing continued operation of IP-1.

A summary of events, the status of which has not changed in the past week, is as follows:

1. SER Supplement Issued - November 15, 1974
2. FES Issued - December 16, 1974
3. Fuel Loading date - Con Ed projects - February 1975  
RO projects - March 1975
4. PDD - May 18, 1975. This date assumes that the hearing will start on January 14, 1975 and a two month contested hearing. If the environmental issues are settled among the parties an earlier decision date is possible. In addition, Con Ed has filed a motion for an interim license for fuel loading startup testing and power ascension up to 91% power. The board has not yet ruled on this motion.

Status Report for the Week Ending October 19, 1974  
Louisiana Power and Light Company  
Waterford Steam Electric Station, Unit 3  
Docket No. 50-382


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A second Limited Work Authorization (LWA) was issued to Louisiana Power & Light on July 24, 1974, authorizing the pouring of the foundation mat and vertical exterior walls below grade. This is the first issuance of a second LWA. LP&L has indicated they will not proceed with work under the LWA because antitrust may hold up the construction permit issuance beyond completion of the LWA work, and because construction financing cannot be obtained prior to issuance of a construction permit.

The proposed antitrust conditions to the construction permit are acceptable to all parties with the exception of one intervenor. We are now waiting for the Board ruling on the show cause hearing as to why the construction permit should not be issued. The hearing began on August 19 and was completed on August 27, 1974.

No change in status in the past week.

Inquiries by OGC to ASLB have resulted in no indication by the Board as to when a finding will be handed down.
