TELECON WITH ASA GEORGE OF PASNY CONCERNING INDIAN POINT 3

On July 24, 1974 I called Asa George of PASNY to see where PASNY stood in its preparation of an application for amendment of the IP-3 CP and a revision of the IP-3 OL application. The latest information that I had before the call was that these applications would be filed around August 1.

Asa George indicated that PASNY had engaged Stone & Webster to perform a detailed engineering evaluation of the IP-3 and Astoria 6 design and construction so that PASNY was fully aware of what they were purchasing. Stone & Webster is reviewing the design engineering, the construction, the equipment and components as installed, the shared systems between units at Indian Point, etc.

PASNY expects Stone & Webster to have an engineering report available by mid-September. At some time following this evaluation PASNY will file the required applications with the Commission.

Asa indicated that there were many complicated problems to consider. For example, PASNY will attempt to make use of Con Ed operators if possible. However, PASNY and Con Ed deal with different unions with different pay scales and fringe benefits presenting a sticky situation to overcome.

I indicated to Asa that we would like to be kept informed of their progress in preparation of the applications so that we could make the necessary plans for our review. He said that he would be glad to keep us informed.
