But I cannot find anything the CPCN on this limiting. Can you tell me if this limiting of dredging is something I just thought I heard or if maybe there is a law that exists for all projects in MD that limits the dredging to 500 yds from NOBs? Maybe there is a person who is an expert on NOBs and what types of activities can occur and in what distances to NOBs? If there is an expert for the State can I have their contact information.
