Four copies each of Volumes I through V of Amendment No. 13, Final Safety Analysis Report for the Indian Point Nuclear Generating Unit No. 3, are enclosed. The report was filed by Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc., in support of its application for a facility operating license.

Two copies of the Amendment are forwarded for your convenience in coordinating the Fish and Wildlife Service's review with that of the Federal Water Quality Administration.
