

PETITION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE  
BY THE STATE OF NEW YORK

Pursuant to Section 2.714 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and in accordance with the provisions of the Commission's Notice of Hearing dated February 5, 1969, the State of New York, acting by and through its Atomic Energy Council, hereby petitions for leave to intervene in the above captioned proceeding and become a party thereto upon the following grounds:

1. That, under Section 104 of the Commerce Law of the State of New York, the Atomic Energy Council is given the functions of coordinating regulatory programs of the agencies and instrumentalities of the State affecting atomic energy activities in New York, of coordinating the participation of the agencies and instrumentalities of the State in the regulatory processes of the Federal Government affecting atomic energy activities in New York State, and of coordinating the presentation of views of such agencies and instrumentalities for consideration by appropriate Federal agencies.

2. That the interest of the State of New York in the health and safety of its people requires that all matters pertaining to the safety of the nuclear power plant proposed in the above captioned proceeding be thoroughly considered.

3. That, although under Section 274.1 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and Section 2.715 of the Commission's Rules of Practice, the representative of an interested State which is not a party is granted certain rights to participate in Commission adjudicatory proceedings, the interest of the State of New York in the above captioned proceeding may require that it exercise rights which, under the Commission's Rules of Practice, appear to be available only to formal parties to the proceeding (e.g., rights under Sections 2.720, 2.741, 2.760, 2.761, 2.762 and 2.771).
