NOTICE OF CHANGE IN COMPOSITION OF
ATOMIC SAFETY AND LICENSING BOARD

On February 5, 1969, notice was published in the Federal Register (34 FR 1741), scheduling a hearing in the captioned matter for 10:00 a.m., local time, March 25, 1969, to be held in the Hendrick Hudson High School Auditorium, Albany Post Road, Montrose, N. Y., to consider an application filed under § 104b of the Atomic Energy Act by Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. for a provisional construction permit for a pressurized water reactor to be located at Indian Point, Buchanan, New York.

A prehearing conference was scheduled for March 11, 1969, at 10:00 a.m. at the Universal Building, Room 1027, 1825 Connecticut Ave., N.W., Washington D. C.

The notice provided for the conduct of the hearing by a three man atomic safety and licensing board, designated by the Commission, consisting of Dr. John C. Geyer, Baltimore, Maryland;

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Dr. David B. Hall, Los Alamos, New Mexico and Samuel W. Jensch, Esq., Chairman. Dr. Thomas H. Pigford, Waltham, Massachusetts, was designated as a technically qualified alternate.

This is to give notice that Dr. Pigford has been constituted a member of the board, pursuant to § 2.721b of the Commission's Rules of Practice, 10 CFR Part 2, due to the unavailability of Dr. Hall. Notice is also given that Dr. John Henry Buck, Los Angeles, California, has been designated as the new technically qualified alternate for this case.
