This is to give notice that Dr. Pigford has been constituted a member of the board, pursuant to § 2.721b of the Commission's Rules of Practice, 10 CFR Part 2, due to the unavailability of Dr. Hall. Notice is also given that Dr. John Henry Buck, Los Angeles, California, has been designated as the new technically qualified alternate for this case.
