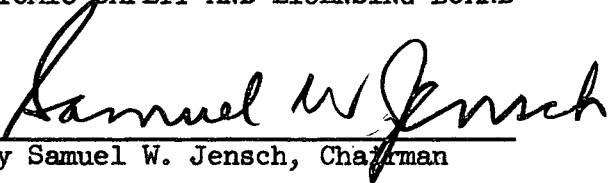
ORDER CONFIRMING RECONVENING OF HEARING ON

On May 2, 1969, the hearing in this proceeding was recessed to reconvene on May 13, 1969. The place designated on May 2nd was the Buchanan, New York Fire Hall in view of the indicated unavailability of the Spring Vale Inn auditorium where the hearings have been held. On May 5, 1969, space arrangements were completed which render the auditorium in the Spring Vale Inn available on May 13, 1969. This auditorium appears to be suitable for the requirements of the number of and the access by the persons participating and attending this hearing.
